Decision Intelligence for the gap between strategy and execution · July 2026

In one paragraph

Strivio is a Decision Intelligence platform that connects an organisation's strategic intent with what is actually in execution, and makes visible where the two do and do not line up. Strivio does not decide for you; it is a decision cockpit and second opinion that substantiates, simulates and learns from your corrections. You start from an existing strategy (OGSM, OKRs, a list of priorities or a strategy deck) or you let Strivio sharpen the strategy with you through domain-focused questions. That way the board and PMO steer with evidence — on facts, not on gut feel and loose decks.

The problem

In complex organisations, strategy lives in documents and presentations, and execution in a portfolio tool. No one sees, end to end, whether execution covers the strategy, where the gaps are, whether choices fit within capacity, and what happens when you flip a switch. Producing that integral picture is manual work: subjective, labour-intensive and out of date the moment it is finished. The result is steering on fragments instead of on coherence.

What Strivio is — Decision Intelligence

Decision Intelligence combines data, domain context and models to substantiate decisions rather than automate them. Strivio brings strategy and execution into one testable picture and keeps the human firmly in the seat. Three principles drive the design:

- **Augment, not replace.** Strivio advises; the human decides.
- **Underclaim, over-deliver.** Cautious, defensible language — 'low coverage' rather than an assertive 'critical'.
- **Reliability is paramount.** One source of truth: screen and export show the same numbers.

Two ways to start

Mode	What it does
Document-driven	Upload an existing strategy: OGSM, OKRs, a list of priorities, a priority list or a strategy deck. Strivio derives testable strategic questions from it.
Question-driven	No recorded strategy yet? Strivio determines it together with you through domain-focused questions (sector, ambition, size, time horizon, priorities).

How it works

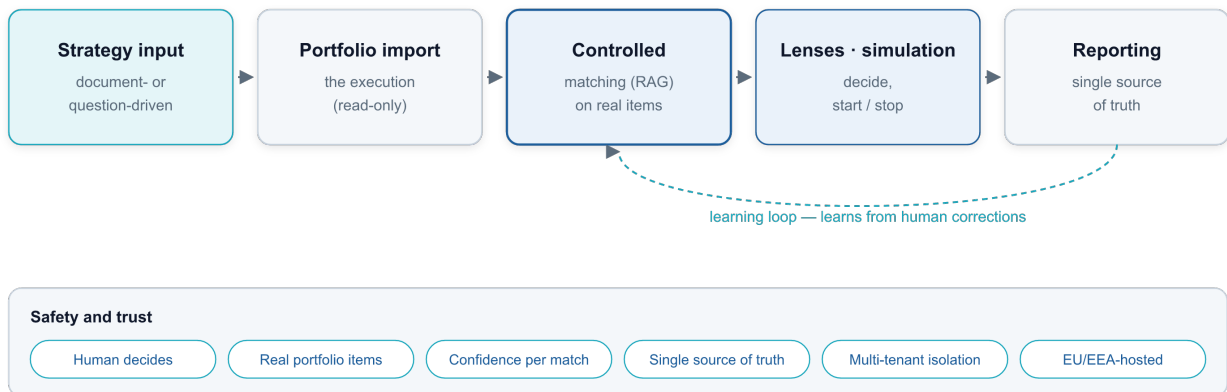


Figure 1 — From strategy input to evidence-based decisions, with the human in the loop.

- **Strategy input.** Document-driven or question-driven.
- **Portfolio import.** A read-only connection to your portfolio tool brings execution in.
- **Controlled matching (RAG).** A retrieval-augmented matching engine links strategic questions to real portfolio items, with a confidence indication — no fabricated links.
- **Agentic synthesis.** The Command Cockpit reasons with an orchestration of agents across the lenses into one picture and a next-best action.
- **Lenses.** Five vantage points on the same data.
- **Decide and simulate.** What-if with capacity-neutral start/stop choices and captured snapshots.
- **Reporting.** An internal PMO report and a jargon-free organisation report.
- **Learning loop.** Your corrections sharpen the matching — per organisation.

The five lenses

Lens	The question it answers
Coverage	Does the portfolio match the strategy? Where is and isn't work committed, now and within the horizon.
Gaps	Where is the tension? What is in the strategy but not (yet) in the portfolio.
Simulation	What if? Capacity-neutral start/stop choices and projection toward the goal.
Health	Is the basis sound? Data quality, hidden capacity and coverage per priority.
Readiness	How far along is execution? Readiness per domain and status.

Decide & simulate

The simulation board makes steering tangible: start or stop initiatives and see the effect on coverage directly, capacity-neutral and with a projection toward the goal. Every state can be captured as a snapshot in one click, which flows unchanged into the reporting.

Reporting — two faces, one truth

- **Internal (PMO).** The full picture per view, with per-domain cards and a coverage summary — one-to-one with the screen.



- **Organisation reporting.** A translated, jargon-free edition: what is committed, what got priority, and — honestly — what did not, per recognisable domain.

Security & trust

- **Controlled matching on real items.** Strivio links only to items that actually exist in your portfolio; where coverage is missing, Strivio shows it as an honest gap.
- **Confidence and human-in-the-loop.** Every link gets a confidence indication; you correct, Strivio remembers it per organisation.
- **Reproducible reporting.** One source of truth: screen and export show the same numbers, and snapshots make decisions traceable.
- **Strict isolation per organisation.** Each organisation sees only its own data; privacy and isolation are by design.
- **EU-hosted — your data stays in the EEA.** Storage and processing, including AI processing, take place entirely within the EEA; your data is not used to train AI models.

Why now

Strategy and execution drift ever further apart, while software is faster to build than ever. As a result, value shifts from ‘can you build it?’ to ‘do you have the right use case, the enterprise trust, the data access and the governance to actually steer on it?’. Strivio brings decision intelligence with reliability, governance and traceability — not just quickly built screens.
